ROLE AND RESPONSIBILITIES

Fertilization Technician:

- Complete assigned Fertilization and Pesticide applications and accurately fill out all necessary information on mobile device while on site
- Ability to work independently to complete all assigned work in an efficient manner
- Knowledge of used insecticides, fertilizers, pesticides, and the ability to safely apply them at the properly calibrated rate in compliance with ODA standards, rules, and regulations.
- Performs daily routine maintenance & safety inspections on vehicle and equipment, as well as keeping everything clean in order to maintain a professional appearance
- Interacts with customers to address and document any questions or concerns, as well as communicating those concerns to Fertilization Manager
- Prepares truck, equipment, and product for the following day's work
- Other tasks as necessary and/or needed in Fertilization department or any other departments due to lack of, or a need for, additional manpower.
- Ability to work in adverse weather conditions such as rain, snow, or extreme heat or cold.
- Involvement in Snow Removal during winter months is expected and required. To include: plowing, sidewalk snow removal using shovels and/or snow blowers, applying salt and other deicing materials to paved surfaces, as well as assisting with pre-storm preparedness and post-storm cleanup.
